FINANCIAL REPORT:

The bank balance as of September 22, 2021 are as follow:

General Account: \$9,361.45 Gaming Account: \$23,975.67

Total: \$33,337.12

We are currently waiting on a cheque from the school of the PAC Donations form the 2020/2021 school year in the amount of \$2,380. We are currently waiting to hear of the approval of our Gaming Grant, we stand to receive around \$12,000. The gaming grant amount is \$20 per student registered as of October 2020. Typically this money comes in October.

They are typically used to fund extra-curricular clubs, field trips (bussing costs), immunizations – snack/juice, the re-hydration station at sports day and the library.
