WELCOME TO A NEW SCHOOL YEAR AT FRASER!

Hello and welcome to the beginning of what will surely be a wonderful year of learning together! We hope you had great summer break and are as excited as we are to have the Fraser Middle family back together.

Below you will find some useful information as you settle into the new school year:

School Supplies: It's time once again to get that back-to-school shopping done. You can find the official school supply list on our school's website frasermiddle.abbyschools.ca. Please do not bring your school supplies on the first day of school because your locker won't be assigned to you right away. It is best to wait until your teachers say it is ok to bring all your supplies to school.

PE Strip: In order to be successful in your physical education class, you need to dress the part. Students at Fraser require the following gym strip: a black t-shirt, black shorts or leggings, and non-marking runners. If you want to show your school spirit, you have the option to order a school logo-branded dry-fit athletics shirt. Orders can be made through School Cash Online, with shirt delivery happening in the first few weeks of class.

First Day of School: The first day of school is Tuesday, September 7 but is only for 90 minutes! The start time also depends on your grade:

- Grade 6: 8:25-9:55 am
- Grade 7 & 8: 10:10-11:40 am

Students will meet in the gym for a welcome assembly, then go with their teachers to their classrooms for the remainder of their time

Bell Times: The bell times at Fraser are now as follows:

- Welcome bell is at 8:15 am
- Starting bell is at 8:22 am
- Nutrition Break bell is at 10:25 am
- Lunch Break bell is at 11:41 am
- Dismissal bell is at 2:21 pm



What class are you in? To find out what class you are in, check your parent/guardian's email! This year instead of posting paper lists at the entrance, you will receive your assigned class emailed to your parents/guardians. Ask them to watch their email and/or school messenger app for class placements. Information will be sent out Friday, September 3rd after 5pm. The first week of school determines our enrollment and whether movement is necessary to balance our classes so shuffling can happen.

Transportation: Do you need bussing to school? The Abbotsford school district has a whole department dedicated to bussing and transportation. To learn about booking bussing including pick up and drop off times and locations, simply visit the bussing website: www.abbyschools.ca/busing

School Cash Online: Fraser middle is no longer a school that accepts cash. To pay for things like student fees, yearbooks, PE strip, field trips and canteen cards, you need to make sure you are signed up with school cash online.
