We are excited to welcome your child to Fraser Middle School for the 2024/2025 school year. We are working hard with your child's previous teacher and our Fraser support and teaching team to develop a strong understanding of your child's needs.

We put much effort into placing all children in optimal educational settings. We consider a range of criteria, including academic needs and progress, physical and emotional maturity, social needs, and connections. Our primary goal is to build successful groups of learners who will work and learn well together. We urge you to trust our team of educators to make the best placement for your child.

Our school transition team has worked alongside your child's elementary schools to create a robust transition plan for each student.

We often hear from parents that their child has requested to be placed with friends to reduce anxiety around attending a new school. While we understand the desire for your child to be with friends, this is only one factor of many in determining student placement in each class. Sometimes, friend groups can impede social emotional growth as students build social skills in a larger school setting.

Making new connections, meeting new challenges, and dealing with change are important life skills. Often, a week or two into the new school year, children adjust and grow around their new surroundings and classmates.
